Privacy Statement

1. Purpose of Collection

The information collected by this application is for the purpose of the Chief Veterinary Officer to assess, in accordance with Section 19 of the *Animal Health Act 1995*, the applicant's request for Special Authority to import animals, animal material, or restricted animal material.
